

You are invited to take part in stroke research.


A stroke happens when **blood flow** to the **brain** is **stopped**.



What is this project about?

We would like to talk to you about the **impact stroke has on a**

family.





We want to find out ways we can help families.

We want to make resources for children.

We want to help families after stroke.

Who can participate?

- You and your family can participate.
- Everyone in your family can be involved or not. It will be their own choice.
- You can participate in your family do not want to.
- Your family can participate if you do not want to.
- If your children are old enough and agree to talk to us, we can include them in the study.

Children can participate if they want.



How do I participate?

- You will be invited to a **group discussion** (focus group).
- The group discussion will last 60-90 minutes.
- The group discussion will be with **other parents with stroke**.



- You can have someone to support you if you need to.
- Some people in the group may need help with communication or physical access.
- If you live in **Sydney,** you can come to UTS.

- If you live **outside of Sydney**, you can do the interview via the internet.
- If the COVID-19 restrictions mean, we cannot meet face to face we will interview via the internet.



• We will **video record** the interview.


How does my family participate?

- Your family will be invited to a different discussion.
- Your child will be invited to an individual interview with the researchers.
- If you have more than one child, they can participate together or separately.



What information will I need to give?

- We will collect information about your family. For example, you and your family member's **name**, **age**, **gender**.
- We will collect information about **your stroke.**



What questions will we ask?

- We will ask you questions about how life has changed for your family because of your stroke.
- We will ask you about support that would help you after stroke.
- We want to know how best to help children after stroke.

How will the information be kept?

- We will keep any information at The University of Technology
 Sydney on a password-protected electronic computer.
- All information will be confidential.
- To protect your privacy, all information about you will be labelled with a code number.

How long will you keep my information for?

All your information from the study will be stored securely for 5 years.

What will happen to the information I give?

The results may appear in journal publications and conference presentations.





- Your identity in publications will be kept private.
- We will send you a summary of the results of this study.

What happens if I decide I want to be involved?

If you agree to participate, we will ask you to **Consent**.



If you consent, it means that you agree:

- o **To participate** in an interview
- We can collect information about you and securely store it for 5 years.
- We can video or audio record you to help us remember what you say.

What if I decide I do not want to be involved?

- You do not have to participate. It is your choice.
- You can start participating and then change your mind.
- You can ask questions at any time.
- You can stop at any time.



What happens if I start the study and then change my mind?

You can stop participating in this research **at any time**. You can stop even during the group discussion.
